- Entire males 2 years and over **MUST** be bitted.
- Horses and Ponies are to be shown in the HEIGHT CLASS that matches what they currently measure.
- Due to time and space constrictions a maximum of 12 entrants of each different breed will be accepted into the in-hand and ridden sections.
- Where entries exceed 12 of one breed, a draw will be held after the close of entries. The successful entrants will be advised of their acceptance and entry money returned in full immediately to those not interested in remaining on our reserve list (in case of no-shows on the day). Entry money will be returned to reserve listers after judging if their exhibit does not get an opportunity to compete in the class or classes.
- Entrants are encouraged, but not obliged, to present in their breed's traditional costume and saddlery.
- By providing these classes our aim is to foster broad participation with the opportunity to demonstrate the talents and attributes that are particular to each breed and to encourage an appreciation of these horses and ponies.

**SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS - Exhibitors, Judges & stewards must follow these Regulations.**

1. **The exhibitor shall at all times abide by these regulations and other rules and conditions as laid down by the New Forest Pony Association of Australia Inc. (NFPAA).**
2. All Exhibitors must refer to the Barastoc Website ([www.barastocshow.com](http://www.barastocshow.com)) on or after the 1<sup>st</sup> February 2010 for information relating to the conduct of the Show. Especially the new arrangements for access to the Equestrian Centre for vehicles not used for the transport of horses.
3. All ponies must have relevant registration for classes in which they are entered.
4. All exhibitors who are current financial members of NFPAA Inc., EV or currently insured Affiliated Club, must provide a photocopy of membership cards with entry form. Membership cards may be requested and must be shown on demand.
5. All Non-Members must complete the Non-Members Application & Release of Waiver of Liability, to be included with entry form, with the fee of \$25 to cover Non-Member Insurance for the dates of Barastoc 2010.
6. An Exhibitor is the owner, lessee or the person who produces and/or shows the pony.
7. Exhibitors must be ready to enter the ring 15 minutes before the time of judging, and will be expected to be in the collecting ring prior to commencement of their class. This is essential to ensure classes are not delayed.
8. Exhibitors who are likely to have Horses or Ponies in more than one ring at the same time should provide additional riders and/or handlers.
9. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor, rider or handler (or their parent / guardian) and the owner of the pony / horse to ensure that they are competent to control and exhibit the pony / horse safely.
10. Handlers of stallions or Colts must have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January of the current year.
11. Handlers of ponies in In-Hand Classes aged 14 years and under must wear correctly secured currently approved hat.
12. In all Classes whips/canes must not exceed an overall length of 75 cms (30"). If misused, in the opinion of the Judge, Exhibitor may be sent out of the Ring.
13. **Exhibitors may not remove their ponies from the Ring during judging, without the Judge's permission. The class ends when the Judge dismisses the class.**
14. There is no age limit for Riders in classes unless otherwise stated with the exception of Stallions in that Riders of stallions must have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January of the current year when riding small breeds (Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh A & B) and for large breeds (Highland, Fell, Dales, Connemara, New Forest, Welsh C & D) riders must have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January.
15. No substitution of entries is allowed.
16. Exhibitors and their grooms must, at all times, present themselves in the Show Ring neatly and smartly dressed. It is recommended that those Exhibitors riding Mountain & Moorland ponies should wear tweed jackets.
17. Correctly secured currently approved standard skull caps/riding hats must be worn at all times when mounted. Approved hats are Australian & New Zealand standards, European standards or American standards NB: A competitor whose hat comes off, or chin strap comes undone whilst competing must, on penalty of elimination, replace it or fasten it before continuing. He/she may dismount without penalty to recover the hat or have it passed up from the ground, or may stop without penalty to fasten the chinstrap.
18. The Judge's decision is final.
19. **A Judge, committee member or steward may require that a pony which constitutes a danger leave the ring.**
20. A fall of pony or Rider in any class will result in disqualification. The Rider must not remount in the ring.
21. **No change of Rider/Handler will be allowed throughout a class without the Judge's permission except where a Rider/Handler is incapacitated.**
22. In open Ridden classes ponies must walk, trot and canter with a change of rein, together as a class (not gallop).
23. No Ridden pony shall be shown on a leading rein except those entered in Leading Rein classes.
24. Mares with a living foal born during the current season are not eligible to compete in ridden classes.
25. First and second winners in each class are eligible to compete for relevant Championship.
26. All Stallions and Colts 2 years old or over must hold a Stallion License, unless otherwise governed by the individual Breed Society, or be stallion adult registered with their individual Breed Society.
27. Entries must be made on the printed form and reach the show secretary with the relevant entry fees, on or before Monday 4<sup>th</sup> January 2010.
28. **Late entries will be accepted. Please note that late entries will not be included in the Official Barastoc Catalogue.**
29. Every exhibitor or competitor shall be bound by and observe the decisions of the Show Sub-committee.
30. The Show Sub-Committee reserves the right to accept or reject entries without assigning a reason. Entries are accepted on condition that exhibitors agree to abide by the Show Rules and rules for the use of Werribee Equestrian Centre.
31. Exhibitors entering ponies do so entirely at their own risk; it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attaches itself to the NFPAA Inc, the Show Sub-Committee or members in any respect whatsoever.
32. The Show Sub-committee reserves the right to divide, delete or combine classes according to number of entries.
33. All ponies must compete drug free. Random swabbing may take place.
34. The Committee Accepts No Responsibility. It is the policy of the Committee to see that all due care is taken to protect property, but the Committee shall not be liable to any person in case of loss or damage by reason of any defect, accident, negligence or neglect however arising.
35. All Exhibitors please note: If the Chief Steward in any ring, in his/her opinion finds the behaviour of any exhibitors offensive or disruptive in any way to another competitor, that exhibitor may be eliminated from that event.
36. Dress for Exhibitors and Stewards - Neat & Tidy
37. Timetable for events will be forwarded to exhibitors. The time that each class is to be judged will be calculated from the number of entries received.
38. **Judges for the various classes are correct at time of printing.** However, it should be realized that situations could change between the time of printing and the show. Therefore if a Judge whose name appears in the Schedule cannot (for whatever reason) meet the commitment, then another person will be selected to take his/her place. Any change of judge/s will be advised in the timetable or catalogue if possible.
39. No prize shall be awarded when, in the opinion of the judge, there is insufficient merit. The judge has the power to divide any prize or premium. The decision of the judge shall be final.
40. It is the competitor's responsibility to check the schedule, when entering, for classes that may coincide and no entry fees will be refunded when classes overlap.
41. The Committee reserves the right to order off the show ground any animal that they consider to be out of control or dangerous. Any person who in the opinion of the Committee, whose conduct is detrimental to the character and interests of the Association may be subject to disciplinary proceedings.
42. Officials and competitors only are allowed in the Judging & Collecting Rings.
43. Competitors must wear jackets in ridden classes and be appropriately dressed for In-Hand classes.
44. Competitors must wear their correct back numbers or the Show Committee will not be held responsible for incorrect results.
45. Entry fees can only be returned on the production of a valid veterinary certificate less \$5 for administration fees.

46. **If the show has to be cancelled for any reason, the Committee reserves the right to retain up to 50% of any entry fee paid to cover pre-show expenses.**
47. Should any question arise not provided for in these rules, it will be referred to the Committee on the ground, whose decision is final.
48. Each exhibit must be able to be identified by checking equine passport or checking brands and/or markings against its registration certificate. Each exhibitor must ensure that each rider / handler displays the correct back number allocated to the exhibit according to the catalogue in each class in which it competes.
49. Every entrant shall be deemed to have guaranteed the correctness of the contents of every entry form submitted by him/her or on his/her behalf. As exhibits are accepted upon the faith of the correctness of relevant entry form, the entrant shall be subject to such fine or penalty as the Committee may determine in respect of any mis-statement or misdescription. A mis-statement or misdescription shall be deemed to have been contained in an entry form if the exhibit on the day of exhibition does not conform in all respects with the certificate of entry.
50. **Protests - An entrant/exhibitor may lodge a protest against a Competitor/Judge.** Protests must be lodged in writing with the Show Secretary within 3 hours of the disputed action. A set fee of \$100, which will be forfeited if not upheld, must accompany the protest. In the first instance protests must be dealt with by the Show Sub-committee. The Show Subcommittee may refer to the matter to the Committee of Management. Any person who has a protest lodged against him or her has the right of reply and defence. Any expense incurred by any party to the said protests shall be borne by that party.
51. Exhibit Numbers will be issued by the Show Secretary and must be displayed as back numbers of all handlers / riders.

#### **New Forest Ponies Condition of Entry & Showing Rules.**

1. New Forest Ponies Must have been registered in a recognized New Forest Stud Book or have been registered with the Australian Pony Stud Book Society as New Forest Pony Section 1, Photocopy of registration certificate / passport required at time of entry.
2. Ponies are shown un-plaited, but may have lightly pulled manes & tails. The jaw line & heels may be trimmed, but the whiskers should be left untrimmed.
3. Clipping, except for the legs, is allowed for ponies 4 years & over, in in-hand, ridden and working pony classes.
4. No makeup is allowed or any other falsification of markings.
5. Yearlings should not be shown in bits. Stallions 2 years & over should be shown in bridles with bits. Chifney bits are not allowed in any circumstances.
6. Judges have been asked to take behaviour and temperament into account & not to judge ponies whose behaviour they consider to be a danger to either its handler/rider or other competitors. Such ponies will be asked to leave the ring.
7. No commercial, stud, or pony names to be displayed in the ring.
8. Entire 2 year old males are permitted to be shown without a license, or APSB New Forest Adult Stallion registration.

#### **Mountain & Moorland Breed Classes Condition of Entry & Showing Rules.**

1. These include all the Mountain & Moorland Breeds, Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland & Welsh A, B, C & D. Must have been registered in one of the relevant recognized Mountain & Moorland Stud Books, with parentage tracing entirely back to the British Isles. Photocopy of registration certificate / passport required at time of entry.
2. In all Mountain & Moorland Classes, Ridden and In-Hand, ponies are to be trimmed only within their Breed Society specification. Manes must not be plaited and tails not braided. *Judges must take special note of this.*
3. Ponies are restricted to the height limits laid down by their appropriate Breed Societies and may be measured at the Judge's discretion.
4. Youngstock may be shown in a halter, leather head collar or snaffle bridle.
5. All stallions and colts, two years or over, must be adequately bitted.
6. Mountain & Moorland breeds referred to in these rules are: - DALES, DARTMOOR, CONNEMARA, EXMOOR, FELL, HIGHLAND, NEW FOREST, SHETLAND, WELSH MOUNTAIN SECTION A, WELSH SECTION B, WELSH PONY (COB TYPE) SECTION C AND WELSH COB SECTION D.
7. Judges should take Breed Type & Manners into consideration when placing ponies.
8. In Mountain & Moorland classes' part breeds are not eligible to compete.

#### **Part Bred / First Cross New Forest Condition of Entry**

Part Bred / First Cross New Forest Ponies Must have provable breeding 25% registered New Forest Blood (one grandparent registered in recognized New Forest Stud Book, or in the Australian Pony Stud Book as New Forest Section 1) Ponies need not be registered as Part Bred New Forest, may be registered Australian New Forest, or in Part Bred Section of another breed society, RPSBS etc. Photocopy of registration certificate / passport required at time of entry.

#### **Part Bred Mountain & Moorland Classes Condition of Entry**

Must have provable breeding 25% registered Mountain & Moorland Blood (one grandparent registered in the relevant recognized Mountain & Moorland Stud Book, or as specified by the individual Breed Society. Ponies need not be registered Part Bred of relevant Mountain & Moorland Breed, may be registered Australian New Forest, Australian Dartmoor, Australian Highland, or in another Section of another breed society, i.e.: Part Bred Arabian, RPSBS any section, First Cross Stock Horse etc. As the WP&CSOA have now reduced their percentage of registered Welsh Blood required to 12.5%, all Part Bred Welsh Ponies with only 12.5%, registered with the WP&CSOA are also eligible for these classes. Photocopy of registration certificate / passport required at time of entry.

#### **Part Bred Mountain & Moorland or First Cross / Part Bred New Forest Classes Judging Criteria**

These classes are to be judged to the criteria of a Sports Horse / Pony

1. Part Bred Mountain & Moorland is judged as a working / sport pony that will do a job for example: - Jumping, Dressage, Showjumping.
2. For this a pony needs to be well made with quality bone and good movement.
3. Temperament is of great importance, as primarily these are ponies/ horses children will ride.
4. Ponies lacking bone and substance would not stand up to the rigors of competition.
5. It is acceptable for a Part breed to be lighter in bone than a pure bred Mountain & Moorland ancestor.
6. Movement would be expected to be more exaggerated.
7. There are no height restrictions on Part Breds, unless otherwise stated by individual Breed Societies.

#### **Working Hunter Classes**

1. No Change of Rider or Saddlery is allowed between phases or during a phase. Protective boots may be used for the jumping phase only. Bandages and protective pads on ponies' feet are not allowed.
2. Marking:
 

Jumping	50
Style of Native Breed Type whilst jumping	20
Breed Type & Conformation	20

**In the event of a tie, the highest jumping mark, followed by the individual performance mark, followed by the conformation mark will prevail. If all 3 marks are the same the Judge's decision is final.**

3. Penalties:
 

Jump knock down	10 faults
First refusal	15 faults
Second refusal	20 faults
Third refusal	Elimination
Fall of pony or Rider	Disqualification
4. No Penalties incurred unless the maximum height of the fence is lowered in the same vertical plane.
5. Fences: For minimum & maximum height please refer to individual classes
  - (a)
    - (i) the maximum spread must be at the base of the fence.
    - (ii) Not more than three fences may be of maximum spread.
    - (iii) The width of water trays should not exceed the maximum spread.
  - (b) The jumping phase will be taken first and any pony eliminated will not be required again. The ponies called forward to the final judging will be those with clear rounds, but those with 10 faults or more can be included in the Judge's discretion.
  - (c) Fences must be of a "hunting type" built with rustic materials and be as substantial as possible. The course must be free flowing to encourage natural paces in native ponies.
  - (d) The course must consist of a minimum of seven fences, one of which must be a spread. A water jump and a change of direction must be included. If a hazard is included, it should be numbered and judged as a fence.
  - (e) A refusal is when a pony turns its quarters to a fence or turns a complete circle in front of a fence, or stops in front of a fence, or stops in front of a fence and takes at least one step backwards, with any one foot.
  - (f) The ring itself must be of an adequate size.
  - (g) No person other than the Judge and the Official Course Builder appointed by the Show is permitted to alter the course.
  - (h) It is recommended that competitors walk the course on foot before their class.
6. Ponies may be galloped at the discretion of the Judge, but not more than one at a time.
7. All ponies may be stripped for final judging.
